# Mamata wants Bengal as member of Indo-Bhutan River Commission

**MI News Service, Jalpaiguri:** West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee has reiterated her demand of setting up an Indo-Bhutan River Commission and said that West Bengal should be made a member of the Commission. "We have repeatedly demanded that Bengal must be made a member of an Indo-Bhutan River Commission. It is necessary because the waters of Bhutan's Sankosh river flood Jalpaiguri Alipurduar also goes underwater," the Chief Minister said speaking to journalists in north Bengal. Mamata. Banerjee who is on a three-day visit to north Bengal has earlier held a meeting with the District Magistrates on the water surge in rivers of the region. In the past also the Chief Minister has sought setting up of the Indo-Bhutan River Commission.

Incidenbtally, in response to a question raised by Trinamool Congress Rajya Sabha MP Ritabrata Banerjee on August 11, the Ministry of Jal Shakti had, however, informed Parliament that there is no such proposal under consideration to form an Indo-Bhutan River Commission. The Ministry in its response pointed out that the primary concern for India on trans-border rivers flowing from Bhutan and entering the States of Assam and West Bengal are recurring floods and erosion in the border areas and the adjoining plains in India. "Accordingly, both the countries have entered into bilateral co-



operation on flood related issues, which consist of a Joint Group of Experts (JGE) and a Joint Technical Team (JTT) on flood management and a Joint Experts Team (JET) on flood forecasting. These expert groups meet at regular intervals to discuss issues related to trans-border rivers," the response added. Speaking about the pending dangers of floods in West Bengal, She said that in north Bengal the rivers of Bhutan, Nepal and Teesta from Sikkim pose risk, while in south Bengal it is the release of waters from the reservoirs from Damodar Valley Corporation (DVC) that causes floods. The Chief Minister has on several occasions called the floods in south Bengal 'man-made' blaming the DVC for the

# 'Bengal cannot be run by remote control from New Delhi', says Mamata Banerjee

MI News Service, Jalapaiguri: West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee has claimed that the BJP and the Union government were trying to take indirect control of the state's affairs from New Delhi, but asserted that 'their ploy will not work'.. At the same time, she also attacked the BJP over the latter's much-projected slogan of "double-engine governments" in BJP-ruled states. "But let me remind you that Bengal could not be pressurised like this. Not from Delhi, the affairs in West Bengal will be managed from Bengal only. The Bengali-speaking migrant workers in BJP-ruled states are being tortured and harassed. I too want to know how much more

"The terrain of West Bengal is like that of a boat. The Ganga in Bengal is still full because of the waters from UP and Bihar. The Centre must therefore think about how much water Bengal can actually absorb,' she said. The Chief Minister claimed that in the Union Budget not a single paisa has been given to West Bengal for flood control., whereas Assam they would be harassed and tortured," Mamata Banerjee said while addressing an administrative meeting at Jalpaiguri district on the second day of her three day visit to north Bengal. According to her, there had not been a single instance of torture and harassment of the migrant workers from other states currently staying in West Bengal to earn their livelihoods. "We love them and, unlike them, we do not oppress them, and they speak of double-engine governments," the Chief Minister said in a veiled attack on the BJP. On the occasion, she also assured that the Bengal government will make all

Sharma Oli government, as they struggle to agree on a name to lead the next interim administration. In an online vote conducted via the digital platform Discord, a majority favoured former Chief Justice Sushila Karki. However, another group within the movement has proposed Kul Man Ghising, following Balendra Shah's decision to step aside despite initially being tipped

as the frontrunner. Meanwhile, the Nepalese Army on Thursday extended the prohibitory orders in three districts of Kathmandu Valley while allowing public movement during specific windows, even as the Himalayan nation gradually re-turned to normalcy. With the Tribhuvan International Airport near the capital city reseveral Indian states are focusing on how to bring back their citizens from the trouble-torn country at the earliest. "The death toll from the violent protests led

by the 'Gen Z' group since Sunday evening had increased to 34," with at least ten more people succumbingto injuries during the last 24 hours following unabated violence and arson, according to the Ministry of Health and Population. Meanwhile, the Supreme

## Accept notices, don't censor oppn', TMC's Derek O'Brien suggests new VP

MI News Service, New Delhi : Newly elected Vice Presi-dent C P Radhakrishnan who will also be Rajya Sabha chairperson, should accept notices given by opposition parties and not censor them, TMC MP Derek O'Brien said on Thursday while putting forward a raft of suggestions. 'The Vice President-elect Radhakrishnan, who was voted into office on Tuesday, should ensure that more bills are sent for scrutiny", O'Brien said in a lengthy blogpost, adding "Mass suspensions should not happen". "Good wishes to the newly elected Vice President of India, CP Radhakrishnan. Eight suggestions for the new Vice President, who will also serve as the Chairman of Rajya Sabha," the Rajya Sabha MP said. The TMC leader said an important tool that enables MPs in the Opposition to hold the Union Government accountable is submitting notices seeking discussions on important issues."In the eight years between 2009 and 2016, 110 notices were admitted into the Rajya Sabha for discussions. In the next eight years, between 2017 and 2024, that number dropped to an abysmal 36," he said.

He said Rule 267 of the Rajya Sabha states that a member may ask the Chair to suspend the business listed for the day, and instead take up a discussion on an issue of urgent national importance. Under the watch of Venkaiah Naidu and Jagdeep Dhankar, in eight years, not even one discussion was allowed under this rule," he said.

## Rahul Gandhi repeatedly violates security protocol, claims CRPF

MI News Service, New **Delhi**: The Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) has flagged certain security protocol "violations" allegedly by Congress leader Rahul Gandhi during his movements, official sources said. The CRPF VIP security wing provides a 'Z plus (ASL)' armed protection to the 55-yearold Gandhi, the Leader of Opposition (LoP) in the Lok Sabha. Around 10-12 armed CRPF commandos provide a proximate security cover to him whenever he is mobile. In his letter, addressed to Congress President Mallikar-Kharge Wednesday, CRPF VVIP Security Chief Sunil June alleged that Rahul Gandhi

was not taking his security cover "seriously" as he was mostly travelling abroad "without informing anyone". The CRPF official referred to Rahul Gandhi's foreign tours to countries such as Italy (December 30 to January 9), Vietnam (March 12 to 17), Dubai (April 17 to 23), Qatar (June 11 to 18), London (June 25 to July 6), and Malaysia (September 4 to 8). The Rae Bareli MP is violating the protocols mentioned in the Yellow Book of the CRPF, the

# India, Mauritius to work towards facilitating bilateral trade in local currencies: PM Modi

MI News Service, Varanasi : India and Mauritius will work together towards enabling bilateral trade in local currencies, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on Thursday after holding wide-ranging talks with his Mauritian counterpart Navinchandra Ramgoolam. In his remarks to the media, PM Modi, delving into close ties between the two nations, said India and Mauritius are two countries, but their dreams and des tiny are one. The Prime minister said that a free, open, secure, stable and prosperous Indian Ocean is a shared priority of both India and Mauritius. 'In this context, India is fully committed to strengthening the security and maritime capacity of Mauritius Exclusive Economic Zone," he said.

"India has always stood as the first responder and a net security provider in the Indian Ocean region, he added. Modi also congratulated Ramgoolam and the people of Mauritius on the conclusion of the Chagos agreement, describing it as a "historic victory" for the island nation's sovereignty. "India has always supported decolonisation and the full recognition of Mauritius's sovereignty. And in this, India has stood firmly with Mauritius," he said. In May, the United Kingdom decided to hand over the sovereignty of Chagos Islands, including tropical atoll of Diego Garcia, to Mauritius under a historic deal. The UK is giving up the rights of the islands after more than 50 years. Under the agreement, the UK will have full responsibility for security of strategically-located Diego Garcia. Ramgoolam is currently on a state visit to India from

September 9 to 16.It is Ramgoolam's first overseas bilateral visit to India in his present term. He will also visit Ayodhya and Tirupati. Prime Minister Modi visited Mauritius in March.

Pm Modi said that "India and Mauritius are not just partners but a family" during a joint press conference with his counterpart Navinchandra Ramgoolam. Following bilateral discussions, a number of Memorandums of Agreement were signed between the two sides after which the leaders held a joint press conference.

While addressing the conference, Prime Minister Modi said that "Mauritius is an important pillar of India's Neighbourhood First policy and Vision Mahasagar". "In March, I had

the privilege of attending the National Day celebrations of Mauritius. At that time, we gave our relations the status of Enhanced Strategic Partnership. Today, we have reviewed all aspects of bilateral cooperation in detail. We also shared views on regional and global issues," he said. In March this year, when Prime Minister Modi visited Mauritius, the two nations elevated ties to 'enhanced strategic partnership' and inked eight pacts to boost ties in several sectors, including maritime security, and promote trade in local currencies. During the visit, PM Modi also announced India's new vision for Global South and named it

# **Woman found** murdered under bed, brother-in-law arrested

MI News Service, North two had soured in recent 24 Pgs: A chilling murder in Sahapur, Gobordanga, has shocked the district after the bloodied body of a woman was found stuffed under a bed in her own home. The brother-inlaw—allegedly killed her and then fled, leaving her sons and neighbors to discover the grisly truth.

Police sources identified the victim as Mithu Dutta, who had been living alone with her two sons for over a decade following her husband's disappearance. On Tuesday evening, neighbors raised an alarm after a foul stench began emanating from her house. Upon entering, they discovered Mithu's body wrapped in a blanket and hidden beneath the bed. Investigators say the prime accused, Pradeep Dutta, Mithu's brother-inlaw, had been in a relationship with her. Pradeep, himself married with two children, had reportedly left his own family and been living intermittently with Mithu. Locals allege that the relationship between the

weeks, leading to frequent altercations. Pradeep initially went missing following Mithu's disappearance. After an intensive manhunt, he was tracked down and detained by police. During interrogation, he reportedly confessed to the crime. Police said Pradeep strangled Mithu during a heated quarrel on Monday night, then attempted to conceal the body under the bed before fleeing. In a chilling detail, investigators confirmed that Pradeep even lay down and slept on the very bed under which Mithu's corpse had been hidden. "The accused has been arrested. He has confessed to the murder. Further investigation is underway to verify whether others were aware of or involved in the crime," said a senior police officer from Gobordanga Police Station. The murder has left the local community stunned. Neighbors, who had long suspected the extramarital relationship, now say they never imagined it would end

# **Gold biscuits worth** ₹5 crore seized along **India-Bangladesh border**



Service, Nadia: The Border Security Force (BSF) foiled a major smuggling bid along the India-Bangladesh border in Nadia district on Friday night, seizing gold biscuits worth around ₹5 crore.

# **Governor to Sub**mit Report on **Border Situation**

Ananda Bose, who is currently in the northern border districts of the state to assess the situation following unrest in Nepal, is expected to visit New Delhi to submit his status report to the Government of India, sources said on Thursday.After arriving in Siliguri on Wednesday, Bose visited Panitanki, a town on the Indian side of the West Bengal-Nepal border, to review the situation. Lauding the alertness of the Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) along the porous border, Bose said the force was efficiently handling the situation."I see an atmosphere of harmony and peace there, and the SSB has been able to perform their duties very well," Bose told reporters. Regarding the return of Indians stranded across the border, he said, "The Government of India is handling the issues very well. "Sources added that the governor is likely to visit New Delhi to submit his report before re-turning to Kolkata. The SSB, however, has allowed stranded individuals to cross the border on foot since Thursday, while vehicular traffic remains restricted. Hundreds of trucks have been parked along the border since Monday after crossborder trade was temporarily suspended due to the unrest in Kathmandu. Meanwhile, reports indicate that the SSB has detained around 35 Nepali nationals attempting to cross into India, possibly after breaking out of jails. Of them, 22 were in Uttar Pradesh, 10 in Bihar, and 3 in West Bengal. India shares a 1.600 km border with Nepal across UP, Bihar, Uttarak-

Rahul Gandhi, a former Congress president, currently enjoys Z+ category security with Advanced Security Liaison (ASL). Z+ ASL is among the highest level of protection provided to individuals facing significant threat perception, and comprises roughly 55 security personnel, including National Security Guard commandos. Under ASL, security personnel conduct early reconnaissance of a place to be visited by their VIP in coordination with the local police and intelligence units. It is not for the first time that the CRPF has written to Rahul Gandhi over his security cover. In 2022, the CRPF said the Congress leader violated security guidelines on 113 ocsince including in the Delhi leg of the party's Bharat Jodo Yatra. # **Bengal Seeks Inclusion** of Swasthya Sathi Card as Citizenship Proof in SIR

Kolkata:The West Bengal government has formally written to the Election Commission requesting that the SwasthyaSathi health card be recognized as valid proof of citizenship for the Statewide Intensive Revision (SIR) of the electoral rolls. The appeal was made by Chief Secretary Manoj Pant in a letter sent recently. The letter urged the Inclusion of three additional cards—SwasthyaSathi, ration card, and Aadhaar card—in the list of documents accepted as proof of citizenship. Currently, there are 11 documents already recognized. The state argued that since every resident of Bengal is issued a SwasthyaSathi card after due verification, the card should be accepted to avoid difficulties for citizens in obtaining voter ID cards. The move follows a recent Supreme Court order allowing Aadhaar as proof of citizenship in a special case related to Bihar's SIR, where nearly 65 lakh were excluded, names leading to multiple litigations in lower and higher courts. During the hearings, the Election Commission's counsel had strongly argued that Aadhaar could not generally serve as proof of citizenship. Against this backdrop, the acceptance

of SwasthyaSathi or ration

cards remains uncertain.

Unsurprisingly, the pro-

posal sparked criticism from the opposition. BJP state president SukantaMajumdar alleged, "The state government is scared. They have allowed infiltration from Bangladesh and given ration cards and Aadhaar to illegal entrants. If voter IDs and Aadhaar can be manipulated, issuing SwasthyaSathi cards is even easier. These can never be considered proof of citizenship." Meanwhile, the Election Commission of India is preparing to roll out SIR nationwide. All states have been directed to complete preparations by September 30, with a notification expected in October. Voter list revision begin soon after, though the exact dates reundecided. On Wednesday, Chief Election Commissioner Jagnesh Kumar held a meeting with CEOs of all states, stressing the importance of readiness. With five states—West Bengal, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Assam. and Puducherry-set to go to polls next year, these states are expected to implement SIR first.

Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee and TMC general secretary Abhishek Banerjee have already warned of strong opposition to SIR in Bengal. Yet, with the rollout expected after Durga Puja, the state has pressed its demand for SwasthyaSathi cards to be accepted.

# Bratya Basu clarifies on TET '22 vacancies

There is no such thing as 50,000 or 51,000 vacancies, said West Bengal Education Minister BratyaBasu, dismissing the ongoing protest by candidates who qualified the 2022 Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) for primary school recruitment. On Thursday, the protest escalated near the State Assembly gate, with candidates demanding immediate recruitment for the alleged 50,000 vacant primary posts. Addressing the media at the TrinamoolBhavan, Basu said the agitation had "no meaning." He clarified that the process of finalizing the vacancy list is ongoing and that the official figures would be released within a few days. "The council president recently confirmed that the vacancy list is being prepared, and I have personally discussed the matter with him.



The official announcement will come out shortly," he

Basu emphasized that the exact number of vacancies has not been determined yet. "It is incorrect to claim that there are 50,000 or 51,000 vacancies. This misinformation is being spread unnecessarily," he said. He also noted that the Education Department continues to support the candidates while assuring them that the

process at the district level is underway The minister further assured candidates that once the district-level vacancy assessments are completed, a formal notification regarding recruitment would be issued. Despite the minister's remarks, protestors maintained that the agitation would continue until the official recruitment notification is released. They warned of a larger movement in the coming days if the government failed to announce the vacancies and initiate the recruitment process.

The TET 2022 qualifiers have repeatedly gathered in Kolkata to demand immediate recruitment, highlighting the prolonged delay in filling primary school positions across the state. The government, however, maintains that the procedure is ongoing and urged patience among candidates.

He also said the panel of Vice-Chairpersons in the Rajya Sabha should not be seen as a "perk", and only those MPs with considerable experience should be chosen to perform this duty. "The political party they are in needs to be [informally] consulted before names are announced." According to O'Brien, visuals of Opposition MPs protesting inside Parliament are not shown on government-run Sansad TV. Stressing that Opposition protests should not be censored, he asked, "Cameras and online edits of the proceedings only show the Treasury Benches. Is this fair?" The new Rajya Sabha Chairperson should also ensure that more bills are referred to parliamentary committees, he said. He said in the 14th Lok Sabha, six out of 10 bills were sent to various committees for scrutiny. In the 15th Lok Sabha, it was seven out of 10. #### **Repair Work to Begin** in Bankura's Junglemahal Following

**Heavy Rain Damage** 

MI News Service, Bankura: After continuous heavy rainfall this monsoon, the administration in Bankura'sJ unglemahal region is gearing up to start repair work on roads, bridges, causeways, and culverts once the rain subsides. Excessive rainfall this year caused significant damage across the Khatra subdivision, leading to widespread deterioration of infrastructure. To address these issues, the administration has decided to allocate an average of ₹50 lakh to each Block Development Officer (BDO), though the amount may vary depending on the extent of the damage in each block. Khatra Sub-Divisional Officer (SDO) ShubhamMaurya said, "This year, heavy rainfall led to localized flooding in parts of Khatra. Strong water currents over roads have caused considerable damage. Work cannot be carried out in the ongoing rain, but repairs will begin as soon as conditions improve.

A BDO In Khatra added that the allocated funds are expected to reach the blocks before Durga Puja, and additional funds may come from other departments. With assembly elections approaching, authorities expect extensive infrastructure development initiatives in Junglemahal. Residents have voiced concerns over the damage. Sunirmal Bhattacharya of Raipur and Ba-

macharanMondal Ranibandh said, "Heavy rainfall has caused severe damage to roads and causeways. Potholes and broken causeways are creating traffic problems, and vehicles carrying patients must take detours. Starting repairs before Puja will be beneficial." Junglemahal has long faced infrastructure challenges. While road quality has improved compared to the Left Front era, significant problems remain. Continuous rainfall since early summer, coupled with consecutive low-pressure systems, has

MI News Service, Nadia: The police have arrested a total of 15 people in connection with the mob violence that erupted following the death of a young boy in Tehatta, Nadia. Earlier, two individuals, Soumiit Biswas and SujitMondal, were taken into custody. On Thursday, in the wake of the mob attack, police apprehended an additional 13 individuals linked to the incident. The tragic case centers on the death of an eight-year-old third-grade student, Swarnav Biswas, whose body was recovered from a pond in Nishchintapur, Tehatta, on September 25. The Incident caused widespread shock and anger throughout the local community. Reports suggest that a neighboring family allegedly attempted to abduct the child. According to the victim's family, when the abduction attempt failed, the boy was brutally murdered and his body disposed of in the pond. Following the discovery, enraged villagers set fire to the accused family's home, sparking mob violence at the site. During the violent confrontation, two individuals lost their lives, while another sustained critical injuries and was admitted to Kolkata Medical College for treatment. Swarnav's father, Satyendranath Biswas, lodged a formal complaint against the accused family. Consequently,

# **Mystery Surrounds Death** of Two Tigresses at Alipore **Zoo, Probe Ordered**

Kolkata's iconic Alipore Zoological Gardens has been plunged into uncertainty and concern following the sudden deaths of two tigresses within just two days. The back-to-back fatalities have raised several questions, compelling the authorities to form an investigation committee to ascertain the exact reasons behind the tragedy. According to zoo officials. the postmortems of the tigresses will be conducted at the Alipore Veterinary Hospital on Thursday. A special team comprising three veterinary doctors has already been set up to carry out the examinations. Sources have confirmed that the entire postmortem procedure will be videographed to ensure transparency and clarity in the findings. The deceased tigresses

have been identified as Roopa, aged 21, and Payel, aged 17. Both, according to the Forest Department and zoo authorities, had been suffering from age-related ailments. It is suspected that old age could have been a contributing factor in their deaths, but officials stressed that the precise cause remains unconfirmed until the postmortem reports are available. The incident has sparked widespread concern among zoo officials,

veterinarians, and wildlife lovers alike. Questions are being raised over whether there was any lapse in healthcare or negligence in their upkeep. To address such concerns, the investigation committee will carefully examine the tigresses' medrecords, and the conditions of their enclosures.

Authorities have assured that once the postmortem findings are made available. they will provide a clearer picture of the circumstances leading to the deaths. In the meantime, the sudden loss has come as a major blow to the Alipore Zoo, which has been home to several celebrated big cats over the years. Zoo officials have expressed deep grief over the incident and have stated that strict preventive measures will be introduced to ensure that such occurrences do not happen again. Additional monitoring of the health and well-being of the remaining animals is also being planned as part of enhanced precautionary steps.

For the Alipore Zoo, one of the oldest and most renowned in India, the deaths of Roopa and Payel mark not just a tragic loss of two beloved tigresses but also a reminder of the need for constant vigilance in the care of aging wildlife.

# **Registrar of Gour Banga Uni**versity Seeks Special Permission to Reduce Semester Fees

MI News Service, Malda: The ongoing demand to reduce semester fees at Gour-University has reached the corridors of the Higher Education Department. Registrar Biswajit Das has formally approached the department, tary to highlight the university's present crisis. In his letter, Das explained that due to the absence of a Vice-Chancellor, no final decision regarding the reduction of fees can be taken, as the Executive Council is unable to meet without the

VC's presence. The Registrar also presented to senior officials the repeated appeals of students, who have been pressing for relief in fees amid financial hardships. According to Das, he will again meet Higher Education officials on Thursday to discuss the matter and explore possible solutions. He stressed that the demand for fee reduction has escalated into a serious issue. and the department's special permission is now being sought to resolve it.

Meanwhile, sections of professors and students within the university have raised concerns over the nature of the ongoing agitation. Questions are being asked as to whether individuals outside the movement are fueling it for personal or political gains. Though no one has openly commented on record, speculation persists that the agitation by 50-60 students out of a total of nearly 1,300 may not be entirely organic. Reports has begun looking into who might be orchestrating the movement from behind the scenes. The TrinamoolChhatraParishad (TMCP), the students' wing of the ruling party, has extended its support to the demand for fee reduction but has firmly rejected any form of disorder on campus. TMCP leaders asserted that while they back students' right to protest, actions such as locking gates and obstructing professors and fellow students cannot be tolerated. Prasun Roy, district president of TMCP, said: "Safeguarding the interests of students is our responsibility. We will support their legitimate demands, but creating chaos in the name of protests and disturbing the university's academic environment is unacceptable." As the deadlock continues, all eyes are now on the Higher Education Department to see whether special permission will be granted, paving the way for a solution to the fee crisis.

# Chicken Prices Surge by 60 per Kg in Bankura, Straining Household Budgets

MI News Service Bankura: Chicken prices in Bankura have surged sharply, rising by ₹60 per kilogram within just a few days. Three days ago, one kilogram of chicken was sold at ₹200, but by Wednesday, the price jumped to ₹260 per kilogram. The sudden hike has put additional pressure on consumers, especially the middle and lower-income groups. Merchants attribute the price rise to reduced supply. With vegetables and cereals already expensive in the region, chicken had provided some relief to households seeking affordable protein. Residents have expressed concern that the higher rates may make chicken unaffordable for many families, particularly with Vishwakarma Puja approaching, forcing some to cut back on their budgets.A district administration official said,

"To keep market rates in check, the

police enforcement department and task force regularly conduct inspections. We will investigate the sudden increase in chicken prices. Any artificial scarcity created to inflate prices will be dealt with strictly."

Pradeep Garai, a meat seller from Satighat, said, "Prices vary slightly depending on the company supplying the meat, and taste also differs. The chicken at my shop was sold at ₹260 per kilogram today. During the Shravan month, prices had dropped to ₹180 per kilogram. Even three days ago, chicken was sold at ₹200. The rate is high now, but it should come down once supply improves." Vishwanath Ghosh, owner of a broiler farm near Bankura town. explained, "During Shravan month, many people in Bankura and Purulia follow a vegetarian diet, causing demand for chicken to drop. Last year, we struggled to sell chicken. Some of our stock goes to Bihar and Jharkhand, but demand there also decreases during Shravan. To avoid oversupply, we had reduced the number of chicks in May and June. That's why production is currently low. We have now increased chick production, and output should normalize in the next two months.' Chicken is a popular source of protein and widely consumed throughout the year.

Red meats such as mutton or goat are restricted for certain patients, making poultry chicken more accessible and preferred. Demand is consistently high except during Shravan, when many avoid meat for religious reasons. Despite the seasonal dip, the recent sharp spike in chicken prices has surprised both sellers and consumers.

## Punjab govt begins fogging in Ajnala, floodhit areas to curb spread of dengue, malaria

Chandigarh: Punjab Government has launched an extensive fogging campaign in Ajnala and other flood-affected areas to curb the spread of dengue, malaria, and other vector-borne diseas-

The initiative aims to protect public health in the wake of recent flooding, which has heightened the risk of disease out-

Ajnala Nagar Panchayat President Jaspal Singh Dhillon stated, "We are conducting continuous fogging in the flood-afcontinuous fected areas to stop any diseases from spreading... We are also conducting the sprays in the areas which are not affected by floods, as a safety precau-

Meanwhile, Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann stated that he would

Service, hold a review meeting on Friday at 11 am to assess the flood situation in the state after heavy rains.

In a post on X, CM Mann

wrote that discussions would focus on the medical facilities being provided to residents, compensation measures, and concrete steps to manage and mitigate the impact of the floods. "I will hold a meeting

tomorrow at 11 am to review the flood situation. In this meeting, the Deputy Commissioners of the flood-affected areas will participate via video conference, and the Secretary and Chief Secretary will join by arriving at my Chandigarh residence. The meeting will discuss the medical facilities being provided to the people, compensation, and concrete steps to deal with the flood situation," CM

Meanwhile, following heavy monsoon rains that triggered floods across several districts of Punjab, doctors and healthcare staff from the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi, carried out a four-day relief mission from September 6 to 9, providing life-saving medical aid to thousands of affected people.

The team covered multiple districts, reaching remote and waterlogged villages where no prior medical camps had ar-

In total, the AIIMS Delhi team treated over 3,100 patients, conducted more than 400 blood sugar screenings, and distributed essential medicines, including antibiotics, antifungals, antipyretics, antihypertensives, antidiabetics, inhalers, multivitamins and wound dress-

## **Gujarat CM Bhupendra Patel visits** rain-affected villages of Banaskantha

Banaskantha: Gujarat Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel on Thursday visit-ed flood-affected areas of Banaskantha district, including Suigam, which had been severely impacted by heavy rainfall, to review the situation on the ground, as per CMO release.

At the Suigam Community Health Centre relief camp, the Chief Minister met with flood-affected citizens taking shelter, enquired into the facilities being provided to them, the losses they had suffered, and reassured them that the Government stood firmly by their side in this crisis.

The Chief Minister also visited rainwater-inundated areas of Sui village and the Jalotra sub-station to assess the situation caused by the heavy rainfall. On Thursday night, the Chief Minister stayed at Vav in Banaskantha district, engaging directly with villagers and obtaining details of the prevailing circumstances.

Later, at the Suigam Sub-Divisional Office, he convened a meeting with the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly, Shankar Chaudhary; the District In-charge Minister, Balvantsinh Rajput; Members of the Legislative Assembly Swaroopji Thakor, Aniket Thakar, and Pravin Maii; iormer MLA Snasnikant Pandya; senior office bearers; the Additional Chief Secretary to the Chief Minister, MK Das;

and officials. The Chief Minister reviewed the rescue and relief operations undertaken by the administration and issued necessary guid-

He commended the efforts of the district administration and urged them to continue working with the same sensitivity and urgency until normalcy was fully restored.

The Chief Minister directed that the disbursement of relief assistance to flood-affected citizens commence from Thursday evening itself. He further instructed that household assistance be provided in line with a structured SOP. In the case of livestock mortality, he directed that compensation be given only after due verification by the Veterinary Officer. He stressed the need to

accord priority to restor-

ing connectivity in Suigam and other border villages. The Chief Minister also highlighted the importance of developing long-

term mitigation measures

to prevent the recurrence of such flood situations. During the review meeting at Suigam, the Banaskantha District Collector, Mihir Patel, through a presentation, reported that 296 villages across 3,416 square kilometres in Suigam, Vav, Tharad, and Bhabhar talukas

had been affected by the

heavy rainfall.

The presentation further detailed the rescue and evacuation measures, noting that a total of 228 persons had been rescued across the four talukas, and more than 6,800 affected citizens had been safely relocated. In addition, two NDRF teams and three SDRF teams had been deployed to assist the local administration.

The State Government has dispatched 18,000 ration kits, each containing 15 kilograms of food grains, to be distributed amongst citizens in the affected areas. Furthermore, 2.5 lakh food packets and 3 lakh water bottles have already been

Electricity supply has been restored to all sub-stations in the affected talukas. Of the 213 villages where power supply was disrupted, restoration has been completed in more than 181 villages.

With regard to drinking water, the District Collector reported that supply has been restored in 168 out of 295 affected villages across the four talukas, including Suigam. Intensive efforts are underway to ensure the provision of potable water in all villages.

To prevent the outbreak of epidemics and disease due to stagnant water, 207 medical surveillance teams are operational in affected villages. More than 7,600 chlorine tablets and 1,040 ORS packets have been distributed, while door-to-door health surveys are being conducted on a priority basis.

Speaker of the Legislative Assembly, Shankar Chaudhary, advocated for chlorination of water at the source itself to ensure safe distribution.

# **ED seizes Rs 75 lakh worth property in Karnataka fund misappropriation case**

in close coordination with

Bengaluru: Directorate forcement (ED) on Thursday seized property worth Rs. 75 lakh of Velohar Infra Pvt Ltd in a case involving alleged misappropriation of Karnataka State Handicraft Development Corporation Limited (KSHDCL) funds, an official said.

In a post on X, ED wrote, "ED, Bengaluru has provisionally attached immovable property to the extent of Rs. 75 Lakh of M/s Velohar Infra Private Limited, under PMLA, 2002, in a case related to misappropriating Government funds from the accounts of M/s Karnataka State Handicraft **Development Corporation** Limited (KSHDCL).

Earlier today, launched search operations at multiple locations in Arunachal Pradesh, Haryana, Delhi, Tamil Nadu and Telangana in connection with a massive fake Input Tax Credit (ITC) case of around Rs 650 crore, officials said.

Such fraudulent claims not only cause losses to the exchequer but are often linked to money laundering and shell company operations.

The ED's searches were carried out under the provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), following information shared by the Goods and Services Tax (GST) authorities.

Fake ITC scams have been a major concern for tax enforcement agencies in recent years. In sever-

floated multiple shell companies to pass on tax credits illegally, creating a parallel chain of bogus transactions.

Officials said the ongoing action is aimed at unearthing the entire network behind the scam and identifying the end beneficiaries.

Last month, the federal agency had also carried out search operations at 12 locations spread across Jharkhand, West Bengal, and Maharashtra as part of its ongoing probe into a similar massive fake ITC scam involving Rs 750 crore. The case was linked to a fraudulent network involving shell companies and unauthorised financial channels used to claim and launder

pandals and puja festivities. A senior Lalbazar official said, "Our priority is to ensure that the people of Kolkata enjoy the Durga Puja

Service, celebrations without fear. Special surveillance will be maintained on empty homes and flats, and identified criminals will be closely monitored."

Every year, Durga Puja draws thousands of visitors from across Bengal and beyond to Kolkata's famed pandals. At the same time, many city residents travel out of town for holidays, leaving their homes unoccupied. Police claim that criminals take advantage of this situation, leading to a spurt in burglar-

In anticipation, Lalbazar has issued strict orders to all police stations. Apart from eas and monitor their activ-

cers have been told to keep an eye on residential areas with a high number of locked homes. The Detective Department has also been given additional responsibility to track and neutralize possible

Police top brass believe that two types of challenges arise during Durga Puja: managing massive crowds at pandals and preventing crimes like burglary and robbery. To tackle this, anti-rowdy officers (AROs) in each police station have been instructed to prepare lists of known criminals in their arpreventive mechanism rather than only reacting after crimes occur.

Furthermore, has directed that no police personnel will be allowed leave during the festival, except in emergencies. Armed forces and additional units will remain stationed in barracks to be deployed swiftly if needed.

With these precautionary steps, Kolkata Police hopes to strike a balance between ensuring smooth festivities at pandals and protecting citizens' homes, so that the city can celebrate its grandest festival without disruption.



# Researchers discover potential new treatment for liver fibrosis

A new study from the University of Pittsburgh School of Pharmacy provides light on the processes that contribute to liver fibrosis and proposes a unique therapy method for this prevalent and serious disorder.

The work, led by senior author Wen Xie, M.D., Ph.D., professor and Joseph Koslow endowed chair of the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, and co-first authors Hung-Chun Tung, graduate student, and Jong-Won Kim, Ph.D., postdoctoral associate, was published today in Science Translational Medicine. In this Q&A, Xie expands on the study's findings and discusses why new diagnostic tools and therapy options for liver fibrosis are crit-

Liver fibrosis is the formation of tissue scars in the liver due to chronic inflammation and injury. Over time, fibrosis can impair liver function and may lead to cirrhosis or even liver cancer. Those at risk include individuals



with chronic viral hepatitis, obesity, diabetes and excessive alcohol use. Early detection and intervention are crucial to prevent progression to more severe liver disease. Currently there are no treat liver fibrosis. The only treatment option is to treat diseases that cause liver fibrosis in the first place, such as hepatitis, obesity, type 2 diabetes and alcoholic liver disease. Preventive measmaintaining a healthy body weight and early screening for liver diseases to prevent fibrosis from advancing to cirrhosis or liver failure. HSCs are a unique cell type in the liver. When the liver is injured or inflamed, HSCs become activated and produce excess collagen and other extracellular matrix proteins. The accumulation of collagen and other extracellular matrix proteins leads to scar tissue formation and liver fibrosis. This study identified the enzyme CYP1B1 as a biomarker and predictor of HSC activation and liver fibrosis in both patients and mice. Inhibition of CYP1B1 led to the accumulation of a sugar called trehalose, which we showed for the first time that trehalose has anti-fibrotic activity. Moreover, treatment of mice with trehalose, its analog lactotrehalose or CYP1B1 inhibitor protected mice from getting liver fibrosis. It was surprising to identify a liver function of CYP1B1, an enzyme traditionally known for its functions outside the liver.

# Researchers discover that unique immune cells stop metastatic cancer


NEW YORK [US]: The majority of cancer deaths are caused by metastatic disease, which occurs when cancer spreads from the primary tumour to other areas of the body. and researchers understand how cancer cells escape the primary location to seed new tumours, it is unclear why some cancer cells produce new tumours decades later and others do

A research team at the National Institute-designated Montefiore Einstein Comprehensive Cancer Centre (MECCC) has uncovered a natural immunological response in mice that prevents escaping cancer cells from growing into tumours elsewhere in the body. The study was published today in the jour-

"Preventing or curing metastases is the most critical challenge in cancer," said study leader Julio Aguirre-Ghiso, Ph.D., director of MECCC's Cancer Dormancy Institute. "We think our findings have the potential to point to new therapies to prevent or treat metastatic disease." The study's co-first authors are Erica Dalla, Ph.D., a former student, and Michael Papanicolaou, Ph.D., a postdoctoral fellow in Dr. Aguirre-Ghiso's lab.

Cells that migrate from primary tumors and seed metastatic tumors are called disseminated cancer cells (DCCs). Some DCCs behave aggressively, immediately starting tumors in new tissue, while others remain in a state of suspended referred to as dormancy.

"It's long been a mystery how some DCCs can remain in tissues for decades and never cause metastases, and we believe we've found the explanation," said Dr. Aguirre-Ghiso, who is also professor of cell biology, of oncology, and of medicine and the Rose C. Falkenstein Chair in Cancer

Research at Albert Einstein College of Medicine. Breast cancer and many other types of cancer metastasize to the lungs. In research involving three mouse models of metastatic breast cancer, Dr. Aguirre-Ghiso and colleagues determined that when breast cancer DCCs spread to the lung's air sacs (alveoli), they are kept in a dormant state by immune cells known as alveolar macrophages

"Alveolar macrophages are the lung's first responders, defending the organ against bacteria and dangerous substances like environmental pollutants," said Dr. Aguirre-Ghiso, These specialized macrophages, he notes, appear early in embryonic development and reside within lung tissue for life. "Our findings demonstrate a new

role for these macrophages, in which they recognize DCCs and actively interact with them, and--by secreting a protein called TGF-b2--produce signals in the cancer cells that keep them in a dormant state," Dr. Aguirre-Ghiso said. "Since every organ in the body has its own set of tissue-resident macrophages, they may function to keep DCCs in check in those organs as well. Our study has shown for the first time that these specialized macrophages function to actively induce dormancy in DCCs."

Confirming the importance of alveolar macrophages in keeping DCCs dormant, Dr. Aguirre-Ghiso and his team found that depleting them in the mice significantly increased the number of activated DCCs and subsequent metastases in their lungs compared to mice with normal levels of the immune cells. As DCCs become more aggressive, the researchers found, they become resistant to the pro-dormancy signals produced by alveolar macrophages. Ultimately, this evasion mechanism enables some DCCs to "wake up" from dormancy and reactivate to form metastases.
"Understanding how immune cells

keep DCCs in check could lead to new anti-metastatic cell therapies among other strategies," Dr. Aguirre-Ghiso said. For example, he noted, it may be possible to strengthen macrophage signaling so that DCCs never awaken from dormancy or find ways to prevent older DCCs from becoming resistant to dormancy signaling.

# Researchers find clues about dementia's behavior changes

MICHIGAN [US] : When most people think of dementia, particularly Alzheimer's disease, they often think of memory loss first.

However, dementia alters a person's behaviour, whether it leads them to become agitated or worried, melancholy, nervous, or apathetic, or even changes their entire personality.

Over time, these behavioural changes can cause as much disruption in their life as losing their capacity to think and remember effectively.

Now, a team of University of Michigan researchers reports new clues about what might be happening in the brains of people experiencing even the earliest signs of dementia-related behavior changes

Using two types of advanced medical imaging to study the brains of 128 people in the early stages of dementia, they show links between one of the brain's most crucial communication networks, a protein called tau, and the level of behavioral symptoms a person has.

This goes beyond the role of tau that scientists have already known about in people with more advanced dementia: causing tangled nerve fibers in brain regions involved in thinking and memory.

The new study suggests that tau disrupts the integrity of the brain's salience network. This highway of connections between specific brain regions is key to our ability to understand and decide how to react to things that are happening around us. It also helps us process our own thoughts and

emotions. showed that the more a person's salience network had been disrupted in the presence of tau, the more behavioral changes that person would experience. They report their findings in Alzheimer's & Dementia: The Journal of the Alzheimer's Association.

While the one-time imaging of these 128 research volunteers can't show cause and effect, the strong association between tau, salience network disruption and behavior change is intriguing, the team says


They call for further study of the potential connection in other populations, and for research to evaluate change over time to explore what might be going on within the pathways of connected brain cells that make up the salience network, and explore how it relates to tau buildup and behavioral changes over the course of years.

They also hope to test whether they could slow behavioral change in people with early-stage dementia by targeting the salience net-work with mild electrical current or magnetic fields applied from outside the skull and guided by precise imaging.

The researchers, from the

Research Program on Cognition and Neuromodulation Based Interventions (RP-CNBI), are led by Alexandru D. Iordan, Ph.D. and program leader Benjamin M. Hampstead, Ph.D. Both are faculty in the U-M Medical School's

lead author of the new study, says, What we see is that the presence tau pathology relates to behavioral symptoms not in a direct relationship, but rather through

dysfunction of a specific network in the brain -- the salience network. The more affected this network is, the more severe the behavioral symptoms." He adds,

The salience network was the only one of the three networks whose level of integrity correlated with the presence of tau and the severity of dementia-related behavioral issues. The defaultmode network appears to be involved as a supporting player. The third network studied, called the frontoparietal network, was not related to behavioral symptoms. The new study showed that unlike tau, the presence of just amyloid in some volunteers' brains was not related to issues with the salience network or linked to that person's level of behavioral symptoms.

Iordan notes that the salience network is also known to be involved in some psychiatric disorders and in frontotemporal dementia, a type of early-onset, rapidly progressing dementia marked mainly by behavioral and personality changes.

Iordan notes that PET scans for tau and amyloid are now used clinically in the diagnosis of dementia, and in managing treatment with new medications that aim to reduce the buildup of amyloid, with the goal of slowing cognitive decline.

But blood tests that can also detect the presence of tau and amyloid, and use them as biomarkers of dementia risk, have also started to become available. Since they're much less expensive than PET scans, they might also be useful in future studies of tau's role in behavioral changes too, he

Further research could also help explain and even predict variation in the onset of behavioral changes in people with dementia, and the pace of decline. It might also lead to ways to idenpeople whose behavior changes are their earliest detectable sign of dementia risk, even before cognitive ability changes

But the most exciting thing to Iordan and his colleagues?

"Our findings provide us with a functional target for potential intervention," he said. "We will soon be able to see if brain stimulation changes these relationships thanks to a larger study led by Dr. Hampstead that evaluates the effects of different doses of weak electrical currents applied to the brain. This larger study is nearing completion, and we are very excited to see what the results show, so stay tuned!'
